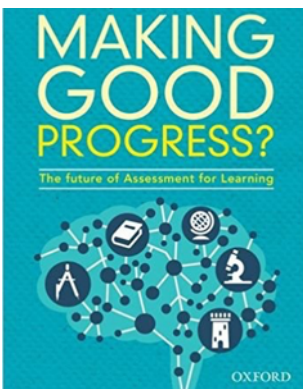

MAKING GOOD PROGRESS

Daisy Christodoulou is currently one of education's most prominent assessment specialists. She is the Director of Education at *No More Marking* and before that was Head of Assessment at Ark Schools, a network of 35 academy schools. Daisy works closely with schools on developing new approaches to assessment and has been part of government commissions on the future of teacher training and assessment.
